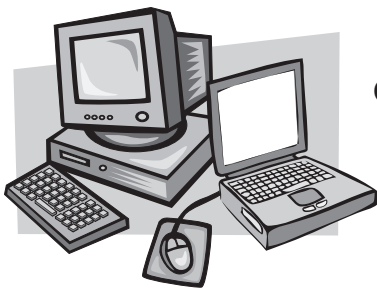


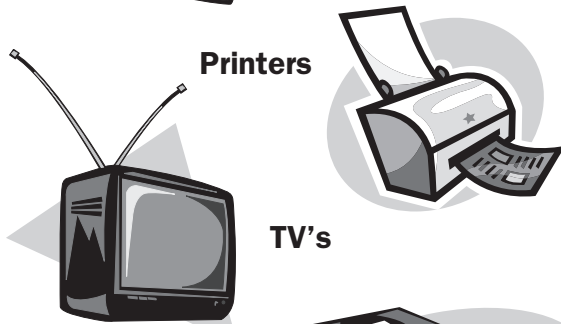
The Do's and Don'ts of Electronic Waste Recycling.

DON'T THROW ITEMS LIKE THESE IN YOUR TRASH OR RECYCLING CONTAINERS:



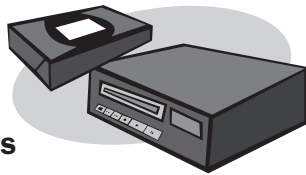

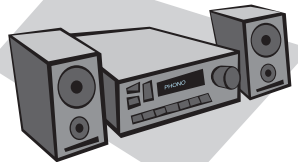

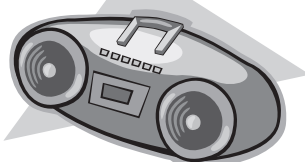
