

What is Natural Mulch?

The County of Santa Barbara's 'Natural Mulch' is an ideal mulching product that is manufactured from 100% local recycled materials. Using mulch in your garden saves water and completes the local green waste recycling loop.





- Moderates soil temperature
- Blocks weed growth
- Reduces erosion
- Improves soil structure and fertility over time

How do I get it?

- Mulch can be obtained for free from a "load your own" pile
- Large amounts can be delivered for as little as \$15/ton* or can be loaded into trucks or trailers for a small fee
 - o A dual axle truck/trailer is required for mulch loads at the South Coast Recycling and Transfer Station
