ACCEPTABLE PLANTS & TREES

- Acacia/Wattle
- Palms (green only, no dried fronds)
- Bamboo (giant, golden, black, etc.)
- Abyssinian/Red Banana tree
- Arundia/Giant Reed

- Fig/Ficus branches
- Mulberry
- Olive
- Sugarcane
- · Willow
- · Bird of Paradise
- Ginger plant
- Grape vine

Branches preferred more than 5 ft. with leaves still intact; dead, leafless cuttings/trimmings will not be accepted.



The Zoo uses cuttings/trimmings to supplement the diets of many of its plant-eaters, including elephants, gorillas, birds, and giraffes. To protect the health of our animals, all donated plants/trees must be:

- Free of herbicides & pesticides, including organic pesticides
- Recently cut with fresh foliage and not dried out or dead
- Free of disease or pests
- Free of invasive and or toxic plants/vines
- Branches cut between 3' and 10' in length
