What is Natural Mulch?

The County of Santa Barbara's 'Natural Mulch' is an ideal mulching product that is manufactured from 100% local recycled materials. Using mulch in your garden saves water and completes the local green waste recycling loop.



What are the Benefits?

- Conserves moisture in the soil
- Reduces erosion
- Moderates soil temperature
- Blocks weed growth
- Improves soil structure and fertility over time



How do I get it?

- Mulch can be obtained for free from a "load your own" pile
- Mulch can be loaded into trucks/trailers for a minimum of \$31/load
 - A dual axle truck/trailer is required for mulch loads at the South Coast Recycling and Transfer Station
- Large amounts of mulch can be delivered for \$21/ton*
 - Small amounts can be delivered in the South Coast for a flat fee of \$62
