We encourage carpooling to the site. We have a maximum of **five cars per group** allowed inside the entrance due to limited parking at the Education Center. (We may park a few cars before the entrance and consolidate into fewer cars.)

Please bring the **printed and signed liability waiver** with you to the tour. We will also bring extra copies if you forget.

**From Santa Barbara (Southbound to North):**

The facility is 26 miles from downtown Santa Barbara on the Gaviota Coast. Take Highway 101 North. Once you pass Refugio State Beach, continue for four miles. You will see a deceleration lane to the right and a lone palm tree marking the exit. There is **no exit sign**. Drive forward and pull off to the right-side area before the entrance gate to meet your group and tour guide.

**From North County (Northbound to South):**

Take Highway 101 South toward the coast. After reaching the coastline, continue for a few minutes until you see the Mariposa Reina exit. Continue driving for four more miles. Look for "Vista Point" signs on your right-hand side, then enter a **left-hand deceleration lane**. There is **no exit sign**. Carefully cross over the 101 Northbound lanes. Drive forward and pull off to the right-side area before the entrance gate to meet your group and tour guide.

## **Waiver and Release Agreement**

Knowing the risks, I nevertheless agree to assume those risks and to release and hold harmless the County, which (through negligence or carelessness) might otherwise be liable to me (or my heirs or assigns) for damages. It is further understood and agreed that this waiver, release, and assumption of risk is binding on my heirs and assigns.
